Theoretical aspect

Insufficient reasonableness and orderliness of terminology

> Absence of theoretical justification of tests for diagnosis

Theoretical aspect

Inadequate elaboration of qualitative indicators of the implementation of methodologies

Inaccuracy of the requirements for the construction of diagnostic procedures, the selection of techniques, diagnostic facilities, methods of processing the results

Methodical aspect

Absence of a unified system of methods for various types of diagnosis of developmental disorders

> Intuitive-empirical approach to the selection of methods, procedures and evaluation of results

Methodical aspect

Absence of data on standardization, reliability and validation of techniques

> Deficiency of diagnostic tools of interdisciplinary evaluation of violations of development of children of different ages, social development environment

Episodicity of screening for developmental disorders

The presence of "defect-centrism" in diagnostics Insufficient expertise of specialists in the field of diagnostics

Insufficient continuity of different specialists in diagnosis
