SCIENTIFIC PSYCHOLOGICAL KNOWLEDGE

- UNDER SCIENCE UNDERSTAND THE SCOPE OF HUMAN ACTIVITY, THE MAIN FUNCTION OF WHICH THE
 DEVELOPMENT OF KNOWLEDGE ABOUT THE WORLD, THEIR SYSTEMATIZATION. ON THE BASIS OF THE
 KNOWLEDGE OBTAINED, AN IMAGE OF THE WORLD (THE SO-CALLED SCIENTIFIC PICTURE OF THE WORLD) AND
 WAYS OF INTERACTION WITH THE WORLD (SCIENTIFICALLY BASED PRACTICE) ARE CONSTRUCTED.
- THE MAIN PURPOSE OF SCIENTIFIC PSYCHOLOGY IS THE SEARCH FOR NEW PSYCHOLOGICAL KNOWLEDGE ABOUT THE INNER WORLD OF PEOPLE. FOR SCIENTIFIC PSYCHOLOGY ARE OF INTEREST GENERAL LAWS OF MENTAL LIFE.
- SCIENTIFIC PSYCHOLOGY IS BASED ON EMPIRICAL SCIENTIFIC FACTS, THAT IS, THE FACTS OBTAINED
 EMPIRICALLY. SCIENTIFIC AND PSYCHOLOGICAL FACTS ARE CHARACTERIZED BY OBJECTIVITY, THAT IS,
 INDEPENDENT OF THE SUBJECTIVE OPINION OF THE SCIENTIST. SCIENTIFIC PSYCHOLOGICAL KNOWLEDGE IS
 RATIONAL AND CONSCIOUS.
- METHODS OF SCIENCE PROVIDE GREATER RELIABILITY AND EVIDENCE OF THE KNOWLEDGE OBTAINED. IN SCIENTIFIC PSYCHOLOGY, THERE ARE RELIABLE AND VERIFIABLE WAYS TO MEASURE MENTAL PHENOMENA.

EVERYDAY PSYCHOLOGICAL KNOWLEDGE

EVERYDAY PSYCHOLOGICAL KNOWLEDGE IS ACCUMULATED AND USED BY A PERSON IN
EVERYDAY LIFE. AS A RULE, THEY ARE VERY SPECIFIC AND ARE FORMED IN THE COURSE OF
HUMAN LIFE AS A RESULT OF OBSERVATIONS, SELF-OBSERVATION AND REFLECTION. THEIR
RELIABILITY IS CHECKED IN PERSONAL EXPERIENCE.
