
The PEDAGOGICAL PROCESS is:

- a set of consecutive interrelated actions of teachers and pupils aimed at solving pedagogical problems.











The DRIVING FORCES of the PEDAGOGICAL PROCESS are the contradictions between the requirements for the child and his real possibilities.
