The first stage is the physical exchange of a graphic image on the subject.

 The goal of the stage is to form the ability to "ask" for the desired object using a graphic image.



The second stage - the spontaneous exchange of graphic images on the subject.

• The goals of the stage are to consolidate the ability to "ask" for the desired object using a graphic symbol; to form the ability to initiate communication.



The third stage - learning the choice of objects.

 The goal of the stage is to form the ability to "ask" for the desired object by choosing from two.



The fourth stage is the "sentence structure".

• The goal of the stage is to form the ability to "ask" for the desired object by drawing up a sentence from graphic symbols.



Fifth stage - "What do you want?"

 The goal of the stage is to form the ability to "answer" a simple question with the help of graphic symbols.



The sixth stage - response and spontaneous comments.

• The goal of the stage is to form the ability to independently initiate messages and "answer" the question with the help of graphic symbols.
