Examples of visual illusions

VISUIAL ILLUSIONS

Incorrect perception of really existing objects (objects are recognized incorrectly, not by what they really are)


These are errors in visual perception caused by inaccuracy or inadequacy of processes of unconscious correction of the visual image (incorrect estimation of the length of segments, the value of angles or color, illusion of movement), as well as the optical ("physical") illusions themselves ("broken straw" in a glass of water)

EXAMPLES OF VISUAL ILLUSIONS [1]



The "physical" illusion is the phenomenon of a broken spoon in a glass of water. It occurs due to different refraction of light in liquid and air environments



Which of the orange circles looks bigger?


Surprisingly, they are the same size


The illusion of perception of size - it seems that all three arrows have different lengths


Are black and white squares straight or curved?


These "intersecting" circles are actually perfect round and do not even touch each other


The illusion of movement - snakes begin to crawl


The illusion of movement - look at the yellow dot, then move to the image - the pink rings will begin to rotate




