BELARUSIAN FOLK RIDDLES AS AN INTELLECTUAL DEVELOPMENT TOOL

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PEDAGOGICAL FEATURES OF FOLK RIDDLES

- The ethnic picture of the world is passed down from generation to generation (sounds, colors, images, associations, grammatical structure of phrases, etc.).
- Enrich vocabulary, learn to feel the lexical, phonetic and syntactic features of the native language: word play, rhythm and rhyme; understand hints and folk humor.
- Get acquainted with the view of Belarusians on a natural elements, flora and fauna, the realities of a traditional Belarusian culture and life.
- Train memory, teach to notice characteristic details, to express an opinion accurately and concisely.

PEDAGOGICAL FEATURES OF FOLK RIDDLES

- Activate intellectual and creative opportunities, destroy stereotypes;
- Are an indicator of observation, intelligence, challenge thinking for speed, flexibility, sharpness;
- Teach to analyze, classify, compare, contrast, generalize, systematize objects and phenomena;
- Pass on the life wisdom of generations and attach it to folk philosophy;
- Challenge, test knowledge of the cultural code, belonging to a particular ethnic group.

FORMS OF WORK WITH FOLK RIDDLES

- Conversations on the content of riddles, explanation of words, phenomena of traditional culture;
- Selection of riddles on a particular topic, about a specific object or phenomenon, by means of imagery, etc;
- Restoration, "collecting" riddles (with missing letters, words, confused parts);
- Editing riddles (replacing words, or parts with others);
- Make your own riddle.

FORMS OF WORK WITH FOLK RIDDLES

- Linguistic and literary tasks: selection by parts of speech, means of imagery, search for mysteries in other genres of folklore;
- Guessing riddles, quizzes, competitions of connoisseurs of folk riddles;
- Pictures to riddles «guess the riddle and draw the answer»;
- Showing riddles (answers) through facial expressions and gestures («Charades»);
- Comparison of folk riddles in different languages, identifying the common and distinctive.
