BELARUSIAN FOLK TONGUE TWISTERS AS A MEAN OF LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT

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PEDAGOGICAL FEATURES OF TONGUE TWISTERS

- Increase the culture of speech, develop diction, articulation, expand the range of voice, form proper breathing.
- Demonstrate the features of phonetic and lexical composition of the native language.
- Develop phonemic hearing, teach perception and pronunciation of sounds specific to the Belarusian language: [дж], [дз'], [ц'], [г'], etc.
- Activate intellectual and creative abilities, teach to feel folk humor, play on words, rhythm, consonance, rhyme.

PEDAGOGICAL FEATURES OF TONGUE TWISTERS

- Easy to remember, train memory, have a perfect shape, concise, fascinating.
- Enrich the vocabulary, acquaint modern man with the realities of traditional Belarusian culture and life.
- Teach, educate: contain moral and educational content, life observations and teachings.

FORMS OF WORK WITH TONGUE TWISTERS

- Phonetic exercises, phonetic gymnastics.
- Reading (slow, fast, chorus), explaining words.
- Reading with different intonation: fun, cheerful, sad, surprised, irritated, etc.
- Pronunciation, utterance, learning of tongue twisters (slow, fast, chorus).
- Conversations on the content of tongue twister, selection of tongue twisters on a certain topic.

FORMS OF WORK WITH TONGUE TWISTERS

- Renewal, "collecting" of tongue twisters (with missing letters, words, mixed up parts).
- Editing of tongue twisters (replacement of words, ot parts of tongue twisters to other).
- Create your own tongue twisters (on topic, for a specific sound).
- Tongue twister expert contest.
- Draw images to a tongue twisters.
- Tongue twister charades.
- Compare different language tongue twisters, similarities in phonetic constructions.
