determination of formation of communicative  
competence of speech therapist students

## Research methodology included:

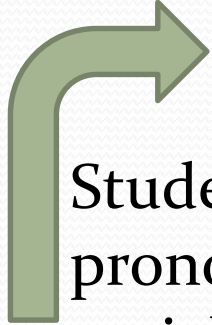
1. Complex of personal *psychodiagnostic techniques*;
2. *Tasks* to assess the normative aspect of communication (spelling, spelling, grammatical, stylistic norms);
3. *Questionnaires* to study the development of intonation and expressive features of speech;
4. *Surveillance map* communicative behavior, which allowed to evaluate the features of verbal and nonverbal sides of student communication.

# Levels have been identified formation communicative competence:

- **High**(10.5%)
- **Average**(43.35%)
- **Short**(46.15%)



## High level of communicative competence

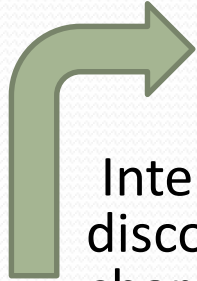


Students with a high level are characterized by a pronounced need for communication and a high level of sociability; the ability to control one's behavior in the process of communicative interaction; the ability to control the expression of one's emotions, to organically use the intonation and expressive capabilities of one's own speech; the ability to focus on communication partners and provide feedback during the communication process.

- At the same time, students have the ability to select means of communication and use them when interacting with various partners in various communication situations.



## Average level of communicative competence



Intermediate level students experience minor difficulties and discomfort when it comes to making contact with other people; the characteristics of communication partners are not sufficiently taken into account; they have an average level of severity empathic abilities, cannot always control their behavior in the process of communicative interaction;

experience some difficulties in controlling the expression of emotions; they do not fully use the intonation and expressive capabilities of their own speech; Not in all cases, interactions are focused on communication partners and show feedback during the communication process.


Students pay insufficient attention to the need to select means of communication and use them depending on the partner and the communication situation.

## Shortlevel of communicative competence



Students who showed a low level of communicative competence, are characterized by a low level of sociability, experience significant difficulties when necessary to get into contact with other people, up to the fear of making contact and avoiding the interaction situation, do not take into account the characteristics of communication partners, empathetic their abilities are practically not expressed, they do not know how to control their behavior in the process of communicative interaction; experience pronounced difficulties in controlling the expression of emotions, their speech is poor intonation, monotonous; When interacting, they are not guided by communication partners and do not provide feedback during the communication process.

Students do not realize the need to select means of communication and use them depending on the partner and the communication situation.

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- The study showed that a significant proportion of speech therapy students have a low level of communicative competence.
