


Biography of A.R.Luria

Luria Alexandr Romanovich (1902-1977)



prominent soviet psychologist and neurologist, one of the founders of domestic neuropsychology, full member of the Academy of Pedagogical Sciences of the USSR

Life Background Information

- Born in Kazan to a family of doctors: his father was a therapist, his mother was a dentist
- Graduated from the Faculty of Social Sciences of Kazan University
- 1924 employee of the Moscow Institute of Psychology; joint research with L.S. Vygotsky, A.N. Leontiev laid the foundations of domestic neuropsychology
- 1931-1932 psychological expeditions in Uzbekistan and Kyrgyzstan
- 1933 employee of the Institute of Experimental Medicine
- higher medical education, defense of the dissertation "The Nature of Human Conflicts"



Life Background Information [2]

- 1937-1941 neurologist at the N.N.Burdenko Neurosurgery Institute
- 1941-1944 chief physician at the neurosurgical hospital near Chelyabinsk
- 1944 defense of the doctoral dissertation
- 1945 professor at Moscow State University
- 1951 employee at the Institute of Defectology
- 1959 employee at the N.N.Burdenko Neurosurgery Institute
- 1967 head of the neuropsychology department at Moscow State University

1968 - full member of the Academy of Pedagogical Sciences of the USSR

A.R.Luria the Scientist

The concept of three structural and functional blocks of the brain (Luria A.R., 1973)

1. Energy block; located in the internal parts of the brain; processes inner information, provides attention, consciousness, memory, motivation

2. Block of reception, processing and storage of information; located in the parietal, occipital, temporal lobes; provides complex forms of processing external information

3. Block of programming, regulation and control of mental activity; located in the frontal lobes; forms goals, provides behavior, the final result of activity
